FIX FORWARD LESSON PLAN

Name: Share the Fix It Cart!

Grade(s): 1-4



Lesson Focus and Goals:

We want the Fix It Cart to be a shared resource, so it's time to present the cart to the school community. By the end of this presentation, we want everyone to know that this resource is available to use throughout the school building.

Materials Needed:

- Completed Fix It Cart (stocked or unstocked)
- 4 printed tool pictures
- Script (see attached)

Learning Objectives:

As a group, students will use public speaking skills and strategies to publicly announce the Fix It Cart to the school.

Structure / Activity:

Teacher/Leader Prep: Print 8x11 images of the four images: drill, screws, screwdriver, sandpaper. Mount these images on cardboard so they are sturdy. Print copies of script for each student (tool images and script attached to this lesson). Ahead of time, assign each student a speaking part.

Presentation Day: Wheel cart to the edge of the stages/presentation area. When it is time to present, children line up and face the audience. In loud, clear voices, children recite their lines and hold up images.

At the end of the presentation, two children model opening up the flip top and remove a drawer and hold it up for everyone to see. Return the drawers/top.

Assessment:

Was the child able to stand up in front of the audience and complete their part?

If not, reflect on why not and make a plan for their next public speaking opportunity.




Script to Share the Fix It Cart

Roles and Notes:

Roles: Announcer and Pairs 1-5

Notes: Assign a strong public speaker for the role of announcer. Thoughtfully assign pairs ahead of time for maximum comfort and success. On the final word, children hold up their image for all to see.



Announcer:

"Good morning everyone! We have been working hard to build a Fix It Cart for our school. This cart is full of tools (will be full of tools) and anyone can use this cart to do repairs. Now, let us show you what materials we used to make the cart.

Pair 1: This cart is made of WOOD! (point to cart)

Pair 2: We used a DRILL!

Pair 3: We used a SCREWDRIVER!

Pair 4: We used SCREWS!

Pair 5: We used SANDPAPER!

Announcer: Thank you for listening and we can't wait for

everyone to get started on repairs!
